PLASTICS RECYCLING



BENEFIT

- Recycling one ton of plastic:
 - Saves 5,774 kwh of energy
 - Saves 16.3 barrels (685 gallons) of oil
 - Saves 98 million BTUs of energy
 - Saves 30 cubic yards of landfill space

ITEMS TO RECYCLE

- Bottles, jugs, tubs
- Grocery bags (verify with your program)
- Pots and plastic toys
- Check recycling logo on the bottom #1-7, check your program



TIPS TO REDUCE CONTAMINATION

- Remove plastic tops from the plastic containers and rinse containers with water.
- Crushing containers will save space while storing.
- Prepare plastic containers for recycling by verifying the code on the bottom:
 - #1 PETE Soda pop bottles, cooking oil bottles, jam and butter jars
 - #2 HDPE Milk, water and juice bottles, bleach and detergent bottles, margarine tubs and some grocery sacks.
 - #3 PVC Cling films, PVC pipes, window cleaner bottles, cooking oil containers, detergent powder containers and certain juice bottles.
 - #4 LDPE Food packaging, shrink wrap, carryout, heavy duty and bread bags.
 - #5 PP Medicine bottles, diapers, yogurt containers, straws and kitchenware.
 - #6 PS Compact disk cases, aspirin bottles, clean plates, meat trays and egg cartons.
 - #7 Other Squeezable syrup and condiment bottles, DVDs, nylon substances, baby milk bottles, various types of electronic casings and some microwave food trays.
- Foam including foam cups, plates and packing materials are non-recyclable.

DID YOU KNOW

- Plastic bottles thrown away each year can circle the earth 4 times. Americans use 2,500,000 plastic bottles every hour.
- Plastic bottles on average, take 700 years to decompose.
- Plastic bags, other plastic garbage thrown into the ocean kill 1 million sea creatures every year.
- Americans throw away 25,000,000,000 Styrofoam coffee cups every year. These cups will remain in the landfill for 500 years.
- By using plastic in packaging, American product manufacturers save enough energy each year to power a city of 1 million homes for three and a half years.
